OACAC NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR ENERGY ASSISTANCE

November 18 2009, Springfield, MO – The Ozarks Area Community Action Corporation (OACAC) is now accepting applications for its Winter Heating Energy Assistance Program (EA) which provides a one-time payment for assistance with winter heating costs for low-income households. In addition, the Energy Crisis Intervention Program provides utility assistance and relief for eligible households to alleviate energy related crisis. Applicants must have received a notice of termination, have had services terminated, or be a COD propane customer.
