What is Weatherization?

The Weatherization Program sponsored by OACAC is a free service for homeowners or renters who are income eligible. Weatherization crews insulate and repair homes to make them more energy efficient. Weatherizing can make a home more energy efficient year round.

Who is Eligible?

All applicants must meet income guidelines. Renters must have owner approval and owner participation to receive services.

How Do I Apply?

Applications for Weatherization are accepted at www.oacac-caa.org or by appointment at the OACAC Neighborhood Center in your county. Center locations are listed on the back of this brochure. If you qualify, all work and materials are provided at no cost to you!

Services Provided

The Weatherization Assistance Program utilizes contract crews and advanced technology to make the homes of low-income participants more energy efficient.

All infiltration measures are used, such as

- Weatherstripping,
- Repairing exterior doors and windows are effectively guided by the use of blower doors.
- Gas heating systems and hot water heaters are tested for efficiency and safety (repaired or replaced if necessary).
- Attics, floors and walls are insulated to recommended R-values if cost effective.
- Caulking.

Using the whole house approach, OACAC will fix the areas that have the greatest impact on energy efficiency. All weatherization measures are cost tested using a computerized audit system.
